The Government Regulations and Guidelines for Disaster Management Act: Regulations for Alert level 4 during Coronavirus lockdown have been promulgated by the Minister of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs, Dr Nkosazana Dlamini-Zuma on Thursday, 30 April 2020. The Regulations for Alert level 4 provide provisions and clarity on the essential and permitted services in line with the risk based adjusted strategy approach. These Regulations are attached herewith for your reference together with the CDC Operational Plan for COVID19.

As outlined in the attached Regulations, the functions tabulated below are permitted to resume and/or continue operations. Therefore, the CDC Business Units aligned to the specified services/sectors and individuals responsible for those specific business activities will be resuming their operational activities on Thursday, 07th of May 2020.
